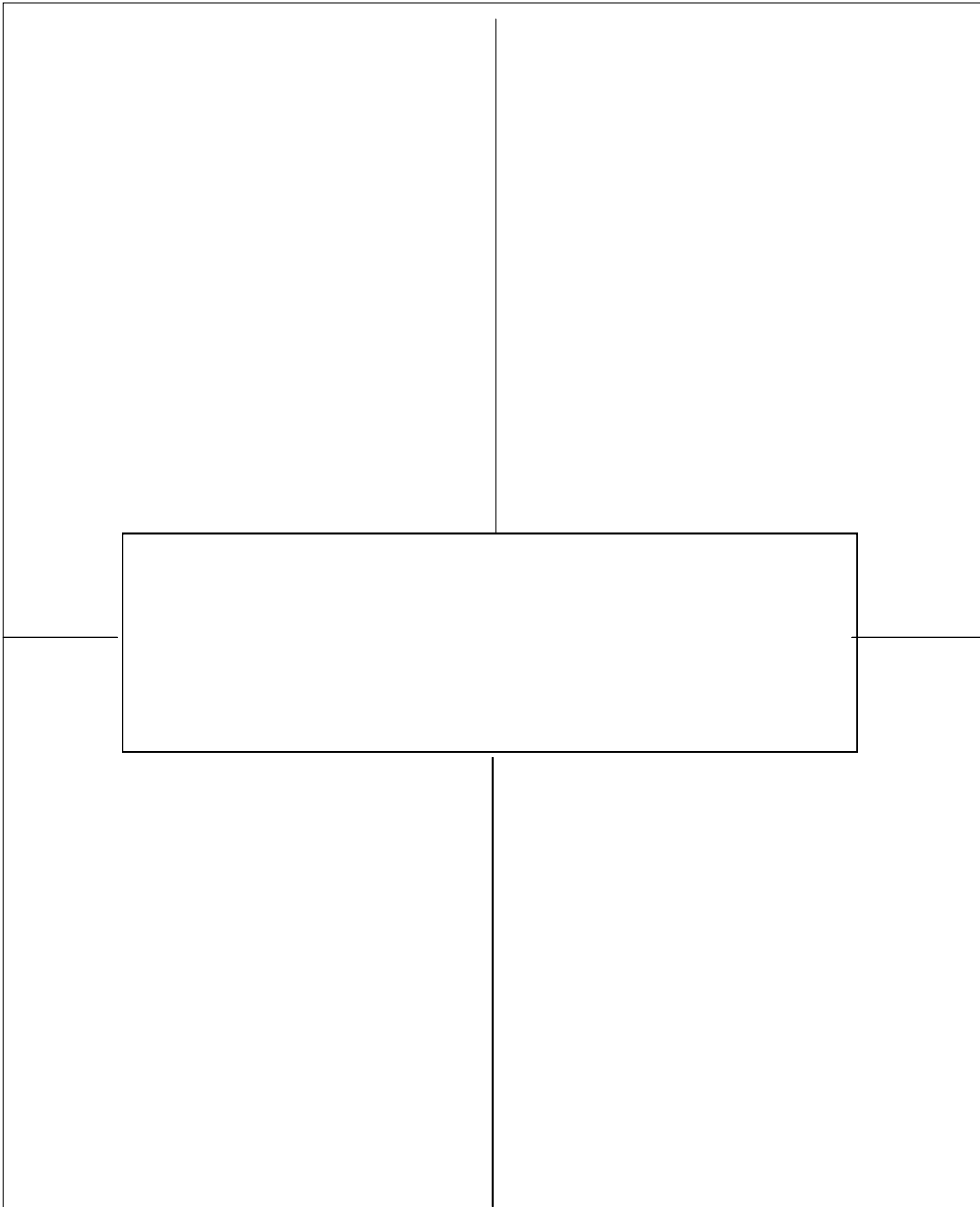


Four-Square Chart

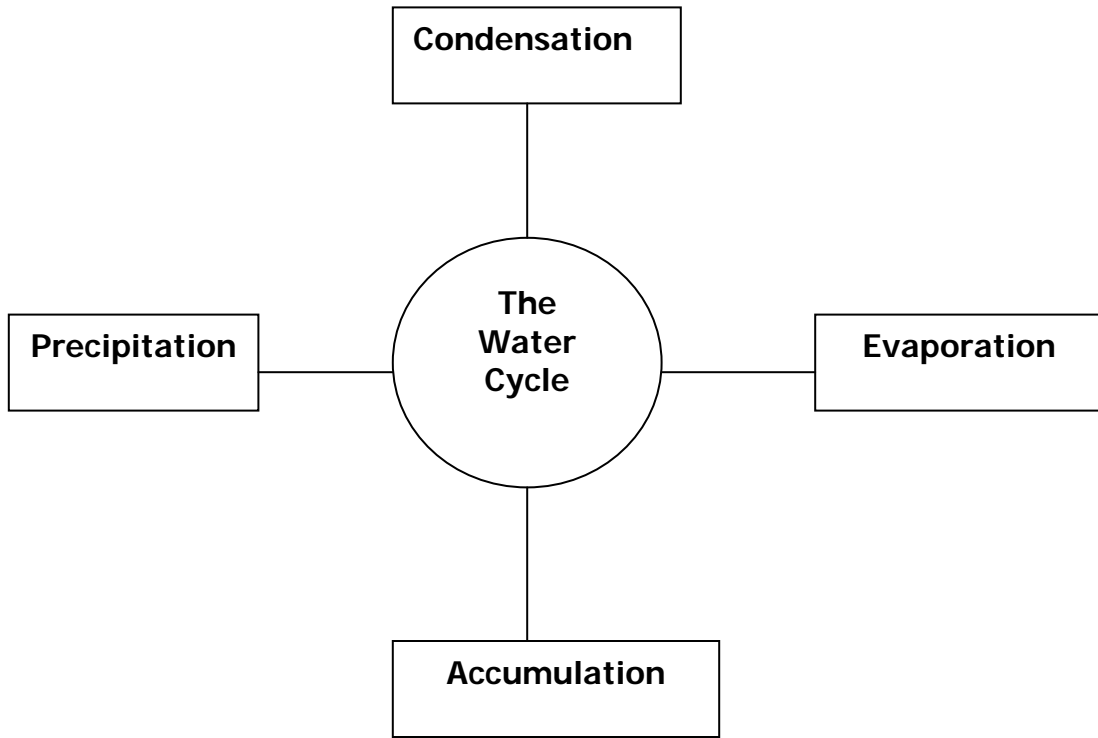

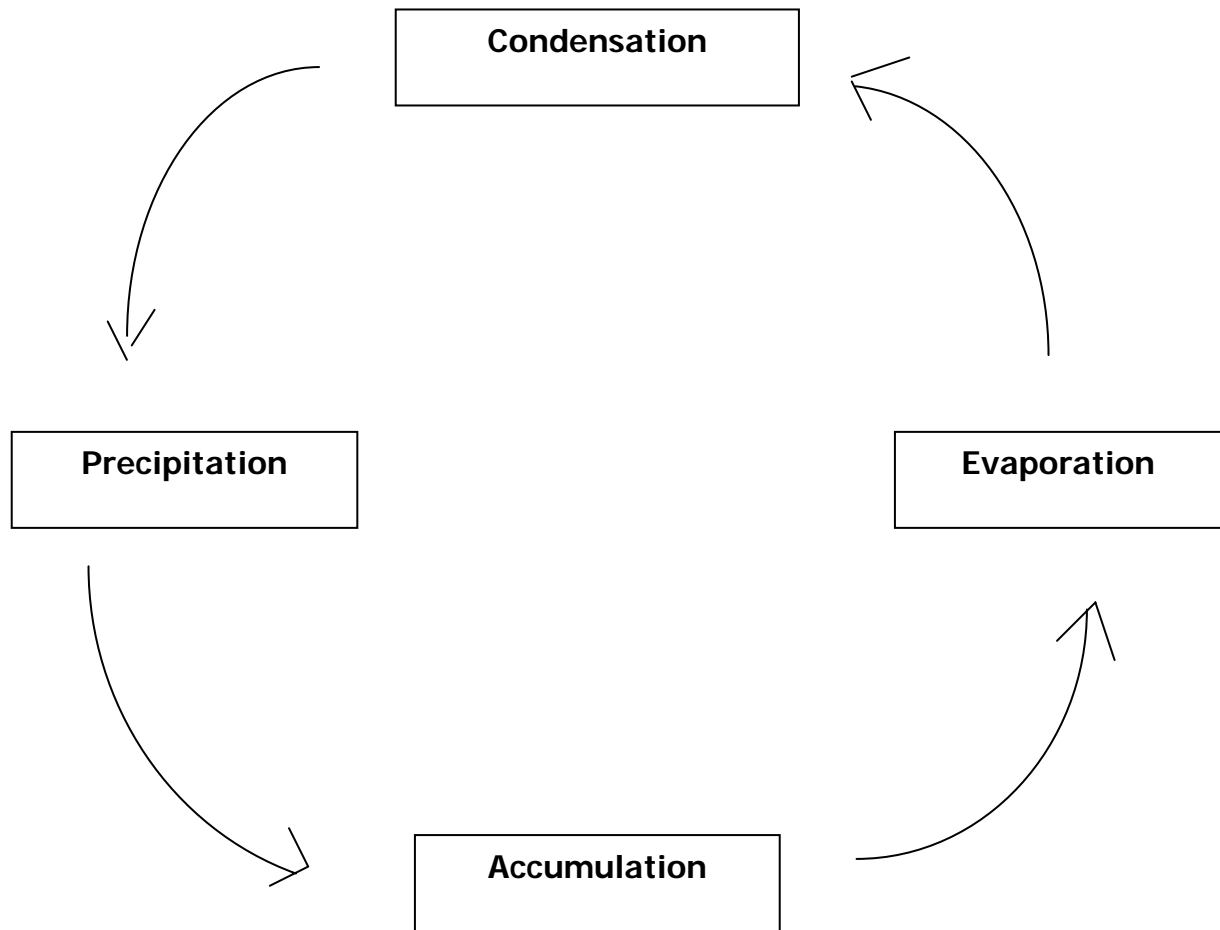
Level of Achievement	Description

T-Chart

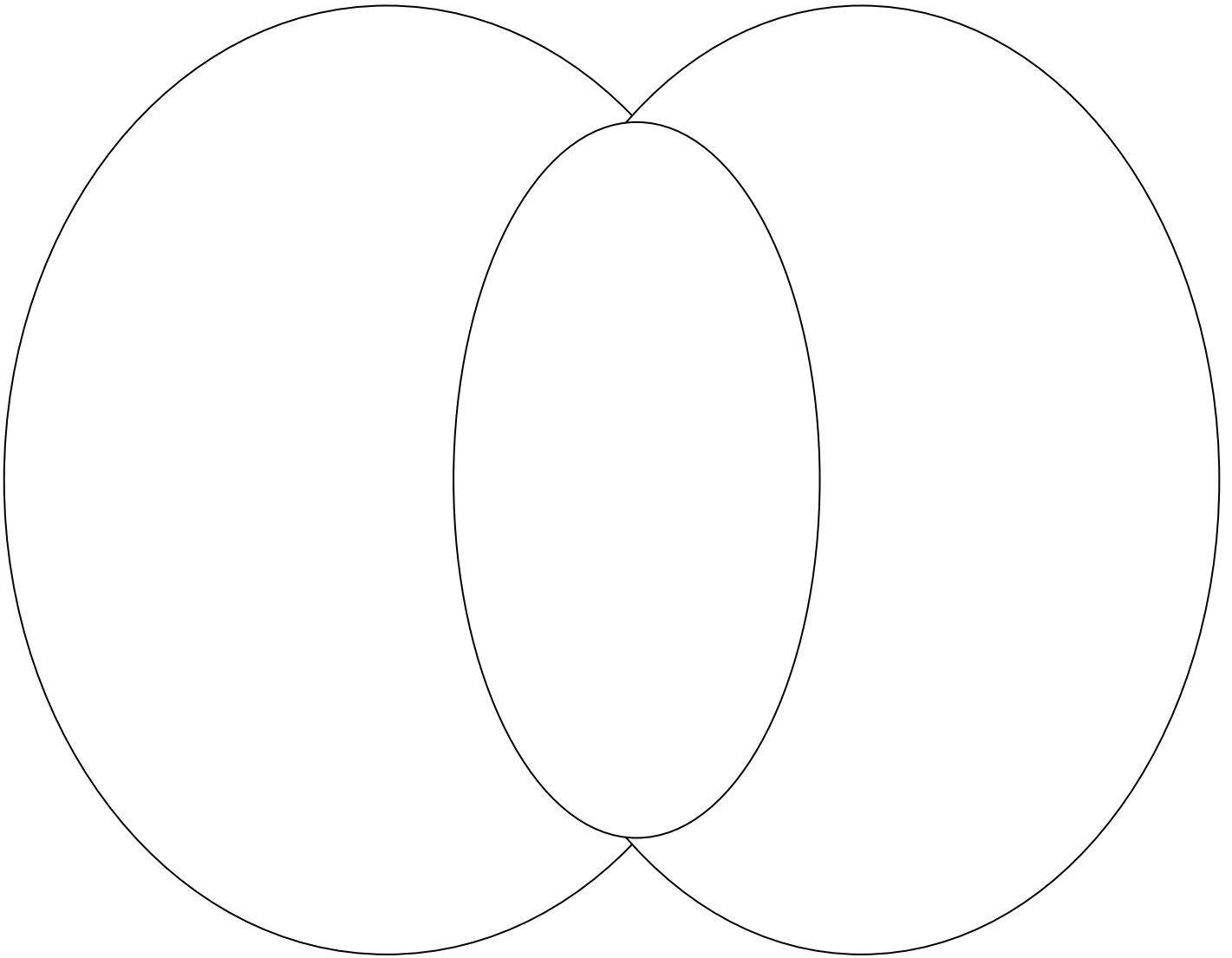
The Water Cycle
